

Hepatitis C: An update

8 October to 4 November 2018

For nurses and allied health professionals. An update on new hepatitis C treatments and strategies for engaging with clients in discussions on hep C prevention, testing and treatment.

Topics covered include:

- Information on the prevalence, spread and history of hepatitis C in Australia
- Changes to hepatitis C testing and treatment in the last 5 years.
- An examination of the barriers to hepatitis C testing and treatment among effected populations
- Strategies for identifying and overcoming these barriers

Who should attend? Nurses, allied health and community workers whose clients may have hepatitis C.

Requirements: Participants will need an email address and access to the internet and will be expected to spend 3 hours per week for 4 weeks to complete the course. The course is counted as 1.5 days (or 12 hours) of study. There will be no set time to be on-line. Participants can complete activities at a time that suits them.
