

## **HIV & Ageing**

A four week interactive, facilitated online course providing skills and resources for health and community workers with older, HIV-positive clients. By 2025, over 50% of people living with HIV will be over 55 years old: this course will equip you to work holistically with this growing demographic.

- HIV Medication, its Effects and Side-Effects
- Complications of HIV & Ageing
- Psychosocial Needs of Older People Living with HIV

**Who should attend?** Health care, allied health, welfare, and community workers; those working in clinical settings or who have clients with HIV. All health workers need to know about HIV.

**Requirements:** Participants will need an email address and access to the internet and will be expected to spend 3 hours per week for 4 weeks to complete the course. The course is counted as 1.5 days (or 12 hours) of study. There will be no set time to be on-line. Participants can complete activities at a time that suits them.
